NOVEMBER 04, 2013

The Special Meeting with Senator Joe Schiavoni to discuss Ohio Capital Budget Funding for 2014 held on November 4, 2013, was called to order at approximately 9:00 AM by Chairman Weimer. After the Pledge of Allegiance the roll call was taken, Chairman Weimer, Trustee Campbell, Trustee Tomaino and Fiscal Officer Schulz, and Senator Joe Schiavone were present.

Chairman Weimer stated that the purpose of the Special Meeting was to discuss the Ohio Capital Budget Funding and to find out what community projects will be considered for funding so that the Trustees can make sure that Milton Township prepares requests for any appropriate projects.

Senator Schiavoni reported that this is all new and that this funding has not been available since 2009. He also stated that he wants to be available to provide assistance and advocate for any projects within our community that we believe deserve funding.

The Youngstown Warren Chamber of Commerce is the organization and Mr. Tom Humphries is the individual who will be making the decisions as to which projects are submitted to the state and he will prioritize them on behalf of our region.

The projects that will not be funded are roads, water and sewers, buildings and government facilities.

The Trustees thanked Senator Schiavoni for his time and said that they would work on finding out if any of the Township needs would fit the States criteria.

At approximately 9:45 AM, Mr. Weimer made a motion to adjourn, 11-04-13-S1,
seconded by Trustee Campbell, and passed with 3 ayes.
