**RESOLUTION TO REGISTER AND REGULATE TRANSIENT VENDORS
WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF MILTON TOWNSHIP
ORIGINAL RESOLUTION 06-17-08
REVISED 05-17-11-11**

Be it resolved by the Board of Trustees of Milton Township, Mahoning County, Ohio, that in compliance with the enactment of amended sub senate bill 80 of the Ohio Revised code 505.94, General Assembly of the State of Ohio and Effective March 15, 1982, all transient vendors as so defined in section 505.94 operating within the territory of the township shall register with the township at the township police department, Milton Police Station, Lake Milton, Ohio 44429, and adhere to the regulations set forth in this resolution by the Board of Trustees.

As defined in section 505.94, Ohio Revised Code "Transient Vendor", means any person who opens a temporary place of business for the sale of goods or who, on the streets or while traveling about the township, sells, offers for sale, or solicits orders for future delivery of goods where payment is required prior to the delivery of goods, except that "transient vendor" does include any person who includes, but not limited to any entity exempted from taxation under section 5709.04 of the Ohio Revised Code, that notifies a member of the Board or Township Trustees, Police Chief, Zoning Inspector or the Police Secretary, that its representatives are present in the township for the purpose of selling, offering for sale, or soliciting orders for future goods, or an auction or and auctioneer company licensed under Chapter 4707 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 1

That all transient vendor's in registering with the township shall pay a registration fee of \$150.00 per person for a valid period not to exceed ninety (90) days.

SECTION 2

That no transient vendor shall offer for sale goods on vacant property within the township without first having obtained a letter of authorization from the property owner and producing proof of said authorization upon registration with the township. Both authorizations and the transient vendors permit must be conspicuously displayed at the place of business operation. In addition the authorization and permit must be shown to anyone who asks to view the same.

SECTION 3

The hours of transient vendor's shall be from 9:00 AM until 4:00 PM, Monday through Friday.

SECTION 4

Transient vendors must comply fully with all township zoning codes, such as setback, sidelines, sign regulation, etc.

SECTION 5

Transient vendors shall not be located so as to cause a health or safety problem, or operate in or cause an unsafe traffic situation. Police personnel on duty will be authorized to determine if a safety or health problem exists, and will be empowered to immediately terminate any permit in force.

SECTION 6

Any resident growing produce on their property shall not be deemed a transient vendor if said produce is sold on the same property.

SECTION 7

The township reserves the right to waive the permit for any non-profit organization which currently has a 501 C3 or C4 designation.

SECTION 8

That no transient vendor shall fail to register or to comply with the regulations established by the Trustees. Any person or firm violating the provisions of this section shall be liable to the penalty as set forth in section 505.99 ORC.

Passed and approved the 17th day of June 2008 by the Board of Trustees of Milton Township, Mahoning County, Ohio. The resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the date of June 17, 2008.

Revised and approved the 11th day of May 2011 by the Board of Trustees of Milton Township, Mahoning County, Ohio. The amendments shall take effect and be in force from and after the date of May 11, 2011.
